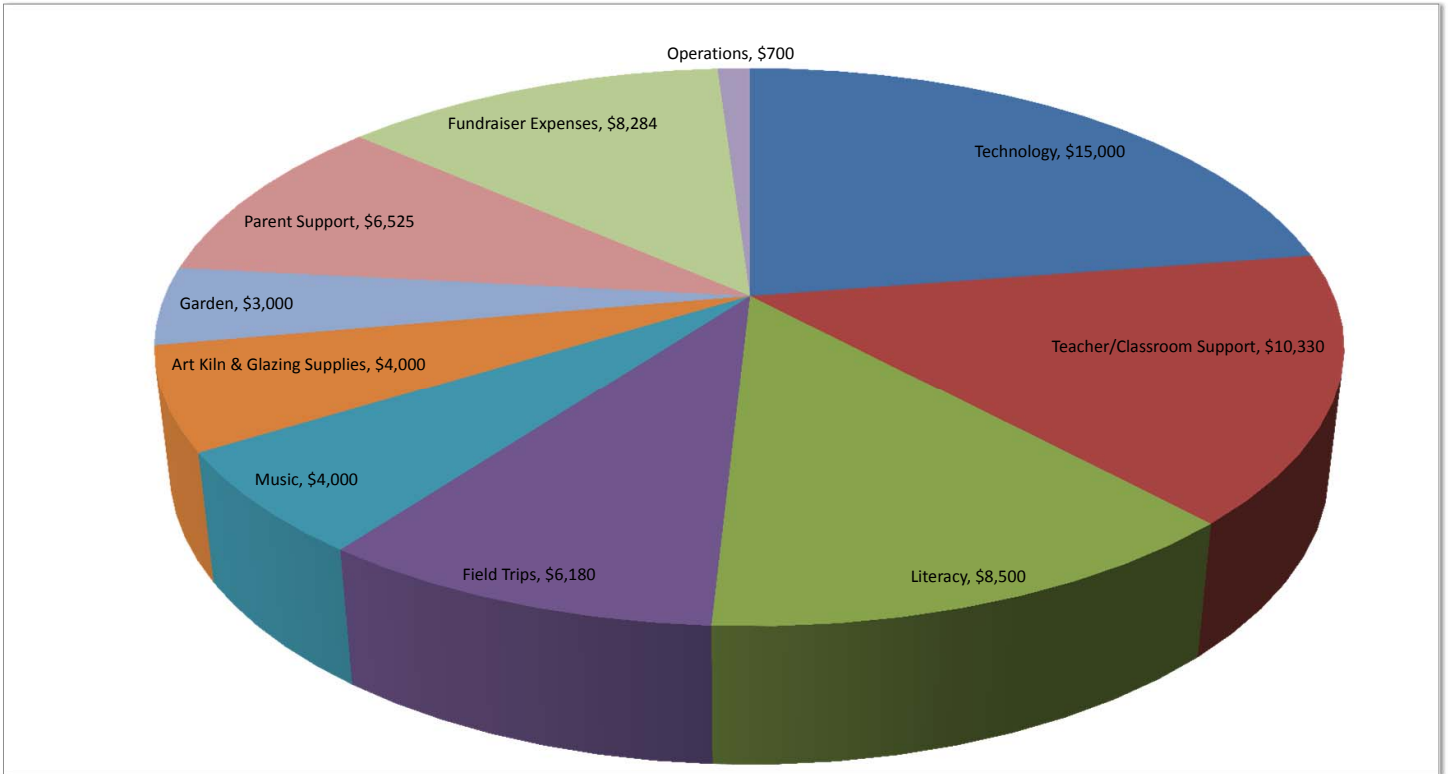


Sunol Glen Community Club Grants (and expenses) for 2014/15

Total anticipated expenditures: \$66,519



Here is a summary of some of the highlights:

Technology allocation will go toward iPads for each classroom (the goal is to have 4–5 iPads per grade level), with any excess going to additional student laptops. Staff technology liaisons will work together to evaluate needs and make purchasing decisions.

Field Trip subsidy will continue at \$500/class, plus \$680 to the Field Trip Student Aid fund to restore that account to \$2,000.

Teacher/Classroom Support includes many of the programs that Sunol Glen supports, including Science Fair, Spelling Bee, Earth Week, Socials, F.A.M.E., and more. It also encompasses staff hospitality, staff appreciation week, and more. In addition, we are allocating funds to support teachers' need for large-format printing. Teacher Discretionary Funds will be allocated in the spring.

Music donation will allow our music department to continue to build instrument inventory, as well as add some fun rhythm and percussion instruments and purchase sheet music.

Art donation will go toward purchasing a kiln and ceramics supplies for the art department.

Literacy allocation will give each classroom \$500, plus \$3,000 to purchase a color printer and a large area rug for library, as well as increase grade-level non-fiction and other titles in school library.

Garden allocation provides support for our garden program to continue to grow, and for our students to maximize their use of our wonderful outdoor classroom.

Parent Support allocation provides continued volunteer recognition for parents, Distinguished School car magnets, and will cover the cost of adding a large corkboard along the office hallway wall. In addition, a high quality solar light will be added to the parking lot for improved safety for staff and parents leaving the grounds at night.

Fundraiser Expenses covers cost of Walkathon (mainly the printing of T-shirts), as well as food/venue/entertainment costs for Spring Fling fundraiser.
